**PICKUP  
 DAYS**

<p><b>RECYCLING</b> – all materials must be placed curbside after 7 p.m. on the night before collection date in residential areas.  <b>Do not place items in plastic bags.</b>  <b>COMMINGLED ITEMS:</b> <i>GLASS:</i> only food and beverage containers made of unbroken clear, brown or green glass. <i>METAL CONTAINERS:</i> food and beverage containers, clean aluminum foil and trays, and empty aerosol cans. <i>PLASTICS:</i> Only PET and HDPE plastic containers (code 1 and 2 printed on container) commonly used for food, beverages, detergents or shampoos.      All commingled items should be rinsed, lids removed then combined in one bin or more. Metal lids can be placed in the bin with commingled items and plastic lids should be placed in your regular garbage. Labels need not be removed.  <b>PAPER ITEMS: NEWSPAPERS, OUTDATED PHONE BOOKS, PAPERBACK AND HARDCOVER BOOKS (COVERS REMOVED), MAGAZINES, JUNK MAIL, BROCHURES, CATALOGS, ADVERTISEMENTS, LETTERS &amp; ENVELOPES, CEREAL, TISSUE, AND CLEAN PIZZA BOXES:</b> Place at curbside in a bin, brown paper bags, or a small corrugated cardboard box. Do not bundle them with cord, twine or rope, or put them in plastic bags.  <b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD &amp; BROWN PAPER BAGS:</b> Remove excessive amounts of adhesive tape, tie in bundles or break down and box. Do not place in plastic bags.      You may combine all paper items for pickup. Please remember not to tie anything in bundles except for corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags. Do not place items in plastic bags. Blue Recycle bags ARE NOT accepted at the MRF.</p>	<p>Light bulbs, kitchenware, crystal, mirrors &amp; windows, paint cans, pesticide containers, oil cans, five gallon pails, foam plastic, plastic bags and flower pots. <p><b>HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE</b> – must be placed in container by 7:00 a.m. on pick up day      All household waste, other than recyclable waste and organic waste, which is compactible and which can be put into a bag and placed in a 32 or 33 gallon container.</p>	<p>Recyclable, household hazardous wastes, large items qualifying for bulk pickup</p>	<p><b>AREA A:        MON/THURS</b>  <b>AREA B:        TUES/FRI</b></p>
<p><b>BULK RUBBISH</b> – all materials must be placed curbside after 7 p.m. on the night before collection date in residential areas.      Defined as all items that you would not usually discard in your household garbage. These items usually include such things as furniture, large toys, carpets*, etc. and are discarded only on Weds. These items must be placed curbside but not before 7 p.m. Tues. evening before Wed. collection. Cardboard will not be picked up on bulk rubbish days. *Carpets must be cut in 3 foot sections; rolled and tied</p>	<p>Car batteries, car tires, glass, building materials, debris from construction work, bath tubs, sinks, toilets, tree stumps, logs, concrete, cement, asphalt, rocks and dirt. <p><b>TELEVISIONS AND COMPUTER MONITORS</b>      Computer Monitors and Televisions contain CRT (Cathode Ray Tubes) that contain lead and are no longer acceptable at the landfill. Please call Village Hall to arrange for a pick up. <b>738-2015</b></p>		<p>Call Village Hall for collection dates</p>
<p><b>BULK METAL</b>      Defined as most metal items that you would normally discard of in your trash collection. Some of these items include: dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, iron fencing, refrigerators and air conditioners (freon removed and certified), stoves, hot water heaters, metal and iron piping, metal file cabinets and shelving. Please call Village Hall if you have any questions on bulk metal items. Refrigerator doors must be removed.</p>		<p><b>1ST TUES        EACH MONTH</b>        (Please See Schedule)</p>
<p><b>ORGANIC WASTE</b> – APRIL 6th to DECEMBER 15th – all organic must be placed curbside after 7 p.m. on night before collection date on specified days only.      All grass clippings, flowers, leaves, brush, small branches and twigs must be put in either a biodegradable paper bag or an open 30-35 gallon container. Garbage CANNOT be mixed in with organic waste. All bags and containers must be placed at curbside for pick-up on specified days only. <p><b>HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE</b>      Hazardous household chemicals should NEVER be thrown away with your regular garbage or poured into the drain. They should be brought to the Household Chemical Day held by the County. Qualifying items are: bleaches, leftover enamels, varnishes, stains, swimming pool chemicals, fire starting liquids or kerosene, pesticides, car batteries, used car tires (max. 10), waxes and polishes; photographic chemicals; gasoline; wood preservatives. <b>Radiological Medical Waste should NOT be disposed of with garbage.</b> These items should be returned to the hospital or health care facility where you or your pet were treated for proper disposal. <p><b>SPRING AND FALL LEAF COLLECTION – LEAVES ONLY</b>      All leaves are to be placed curbside between March 15-April 30 and Oct. 15-Dec. 15. Do not mix twigs, branches, rubbish or any other materials in the leaf piles as it contaminates the piles and they will not be accepted at the organic waste site. <p><b>COMMERCIAL GARBAGE/RECYCLING</b>      All commercial establishments have <b>garbage</b> pick-ups on Monday, Wednesday and Friday (<b>commercial establishments do not have a trash/rubbish pick-up. Businesses must notify the police when they leave trash/rubbish curbside for private carter to collect.</b>) If a holiday falls within the week, the pick-up days are shifted one day. For example: If a holiday falls on Monday, the pick-ups for that week are Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. If a pick-up falls on a Friday, the pick-ups for that week are Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. A limit of 3 (30) gallon containers per pick-up applies to all establishments. Garbage must be inside a container and placed curbside between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. on the days of collection. Nothing is to be left out after 11:00 a.m. Commercial establishments must follow the same recycling guidelines as do residential customers. Corrugated cardboard is collected from all merchants on Tuesday's and Thursday's.
