### **GARBAGE & RECYCLING COLLECTIONS**

#### **ALL GARBAGE, RECYCLABLES & BULK TRASH/RUBBISH\***

- 1) MUST BE PLACED CURBSIDE FOR COLLECTION ONLY ON THE DAYS OF COLLECTION BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. AND 9:00 A.M., AND**
- 2) MUST NOT BE LEFT OUT AFTER THE COLLECTION HAS BEEN COMPLETED.**

\*The Village does not collect trash/rubbish from businesses, but the laws regarding the timing and placement of trash/rubbish for collection are the same as those for garbage and recyclables. Businesses must notify the police when they leave trash/rubbish curbside for a private carter to collect.

#### **GARBAGE COLLECTIONS - MONDAY, WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY**

No more than three (3) thirty-three (33) gallon containers per collection

#### **RECYCLING COLLECTIONS**

##### **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD - TUESDAY & THURSDAY**

Clean corrugated cardboard does not have to flattened

##### **PAPER AND COMMINGLED ITEMS-THURSDAY-FIFTH AVE & WOLFS LANE**

Clean paper items are to be put loose in a container separate from that used for commingled items.

The following empty and rinsed clean items are to be placed in a container for collection:

GLASS - Containers used to store only food or beverages

METAL CONTAINERS - All food and beverage containers as well as aerosol cans

PLASTICS - All HDPE- or PET-type plastics, coded 1 or 2

Chapter 82 of the Code of the Village of Pelham sets forth all the laws regarding the collection of garbage and recyclables. Should there be any ambiguity in this summary or conflict with a Code provision, the Code controls.
