### **Public Comment**

Student Mural Update from prior meeting

Three 8<sup>th</sup> grade students updated the COA on their plans for a painted mural to satisfy their community service project. The location has been selected: the north side of the building occupied by Nicholas Day Spa (203 Wolf's Lane).

There is a mural there (also completed by a PUFSD student years ago) that will be removed and the new mural will replace it.

ET complimented the students for their work and the COA will review their request when they complete a project form and budget. The three students left the meeting.

Discussion continued:

ET noted that this project could be seen as a pilot for future student driven arts projects. LR was not familiar with the PUFSD 8<sup>th</sup> grade middle school service requirement and KP outlined it for the committee.

Contingent on COA approval, motion made to allocate up to \$75 in support of the mural project was proposed by FM, 1<sup>st</sup> by ET and 2<sup>nd</sup> by LR. Passed unanimously.
