

Resolution Establishing a Standard Work Day for Elected Officials Participating in the New York State and Local Retirement Systems

Whereas, New York State Employees' Retirement System Rule 315.4 requires reporting to the Retirement System, on a form prepared by the State Retirement System, with respect to work days for certain elected officials who are members of the Retirement System and who are being reported for service credit and for whom the Village does not maintain time records; and

Whereas, Rule 315.4(b) requires that the Board of Trustees adopt a resolution establishing a standard work day for each such elected or appointed office or position if the holder of that office or position is a member of the Retirement System for whom service credit is being reported.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Pelham hereby establishes the above as standard work days for elected officials and will report the following days worked to the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System based on the record of activities maintained and submitted by these officials to the Village Clerk of this body; and

Be it further resolved, that a copy of this resolution be posted on the Village's website for a minimum of 30 days; and

Be it further resolved, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Retirement System within 15 days after the posting period.
